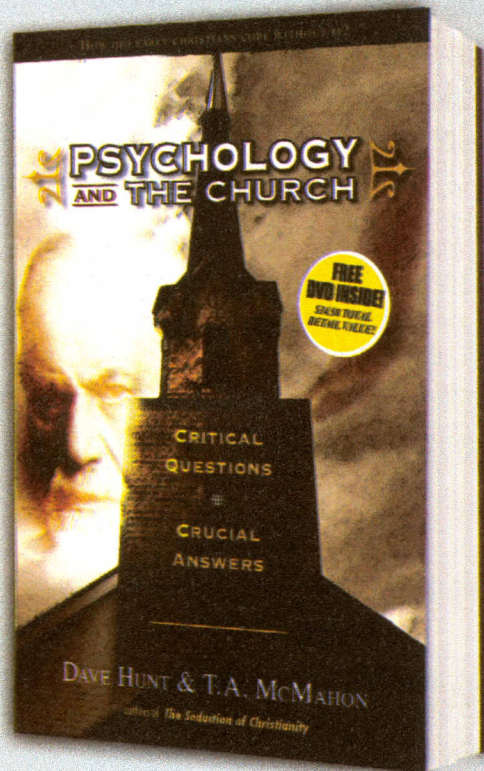


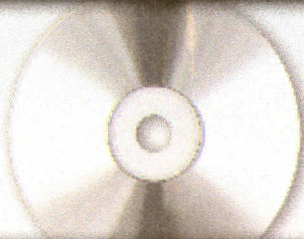
PSYCHOLOGY AND THE CHURCH



Hunt/McMahon—Have believers compromised their God-given “birthright” by accepting counterfeit solutions to emotional and spiritual issues that are common to man? Simultaneously, this compilation exposes—in a biblically incisive manner—underlying concerns that have plagued the evangelical community as a result of embracing what is tantamount to a counterfeit religious practice woven

into the fabric of contemporary Christianity. Some of the critical questions and crucial answers this book explores include:

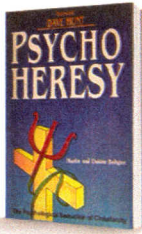
- From what ancient philosophical roots does psychology originate, and what are its modern fruits?

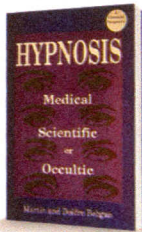


Psychoheresy

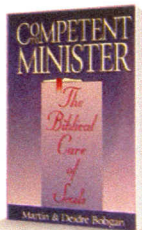


Hypnosis: Medical, Scientific, or Occultic?

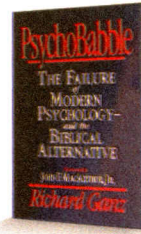

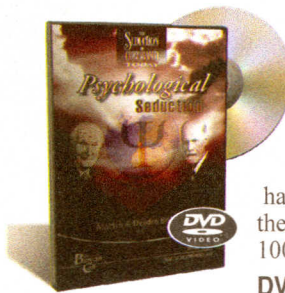
Manufacturing Victims:

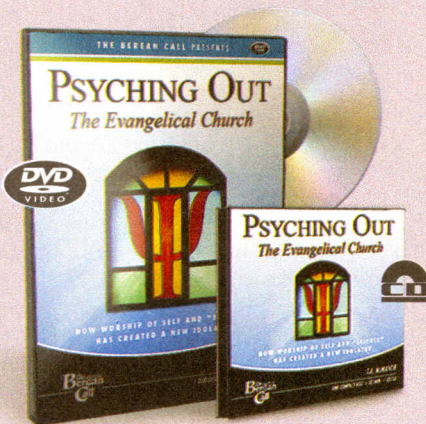

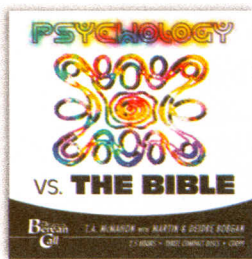
PSYCHING OUT THE EVANGELICAL CHURCH

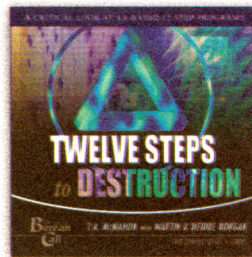


Psychology vs. the Bible
